What would Prop 308 do?

Prop 308 would enable any person who has lived in Arizona for two or more years and graduated from an Arizona high school to attend Arizona colleges on the same basis as their peers. Dreamers are Arizona students and they deserve the same opportunities as other high school graduates.



Prop 308 is fairness for ALL Arizona high school graduates

Arizona Dreamers came here through no choice of their own and are regarded as out-of-state students who pay triple the in-state rate, even though they graduated from our high schools. Prop. 308 would let Dreamers pay the in-state tuition rate. There is no "cutting in line" and they must pay the same as other Arizona students.



Who qualifies?

Anyone who has lived in Arizona for at least two years and graduated from a local high school would be charged in-state tuition rates at the state's public colleges and universities. Currently, more than 3,600 students do not qualify each year because of their immigration status.
